

We have some great news to share! Our neighborhood's [plan to improve the safety of Woodland Park Avenue North](#) was selected for funding by the City of Seattle!

THANK YOU to all the people who wrote to our city officials in support of the project, worked on the steering committee, shared ideas for making the street safer, or just cheered silently from the sidelines. With over 100 residents working directly or indirectly on this project over the last 4.5 years (and more if you ask the residents who have lived on the street long enough to have been a part of the first traffic circle being installed), this achievement has been nothing short of a group effort.

What's next? The city has told us they can have the roadway safety improvements in place by next summer if all goes well. More immediately, for the next two months, we'll be getting the word out about the project and answering any questions. SDOT has given us a general idea of what will be implemented though we are still awaiting the final details. We will tell you what we know as we know it.

In the meantime, We also need to raise a little money and donate some volunteer hours to match the city's funding.

How can you help? We know that you are excited about this project and want to get involved. There are a couple ways you can help:

If you do bake or create anything else magical, please bring it to share!
